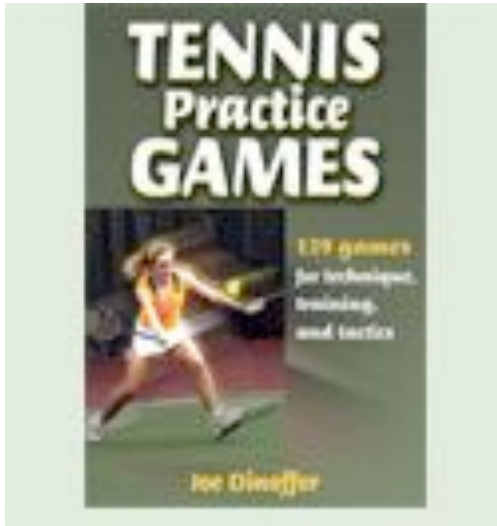


BEST DRILL BOOK?
